


Pool Play - Monday / (Tuesday?)

Returning D1 teams are pre-seeded; unseeded D1 teams and D2 winner from last year will have slot choice at coaches' meeting. Remaining pool slots will be randomly drawn, with random re-draw to avoid pool matchups of local foes. See note on next page re: home team and dugout assignments.



The Home team is determined by coin flip for 4-team pool games, as marked for 3-team pools. For 1st games of the day, Home uses 1B dugout. Teams back-to-back on the same field remain in same dugout. Bottom team from each pool advances to Div. 3; other teams seeded for Q round.






Qualifying Round - Tuesday / (Thursday?)

Qualifying teams will be divided into 2 groups, each of which is ranked for the Q round seeds by record, gamecapped run differential, HTH record, least RA/inning, most RS/inning, coin-flip). Home team is the lower# seed. Q round winners advance to Division I; losers to Division II. Some seeding may await pool tie-breakers at 9a Tue.


Underdog seeds must defeat 2-0 seeds twice to earn a berth in Division I. Replays may be held Tuesday pm if both teams agree and umpires are available; otherwise these are 9a Thur. The higher# seed is the Home team for the replay. Check <u>hwsa.net</u> for potential schedule updates.





Division I - Thursday through Saturday


A coin flip will determine the Home team (1B dugout) for all games. Check <u>hwsa.net</u> for potential schedule updates.
