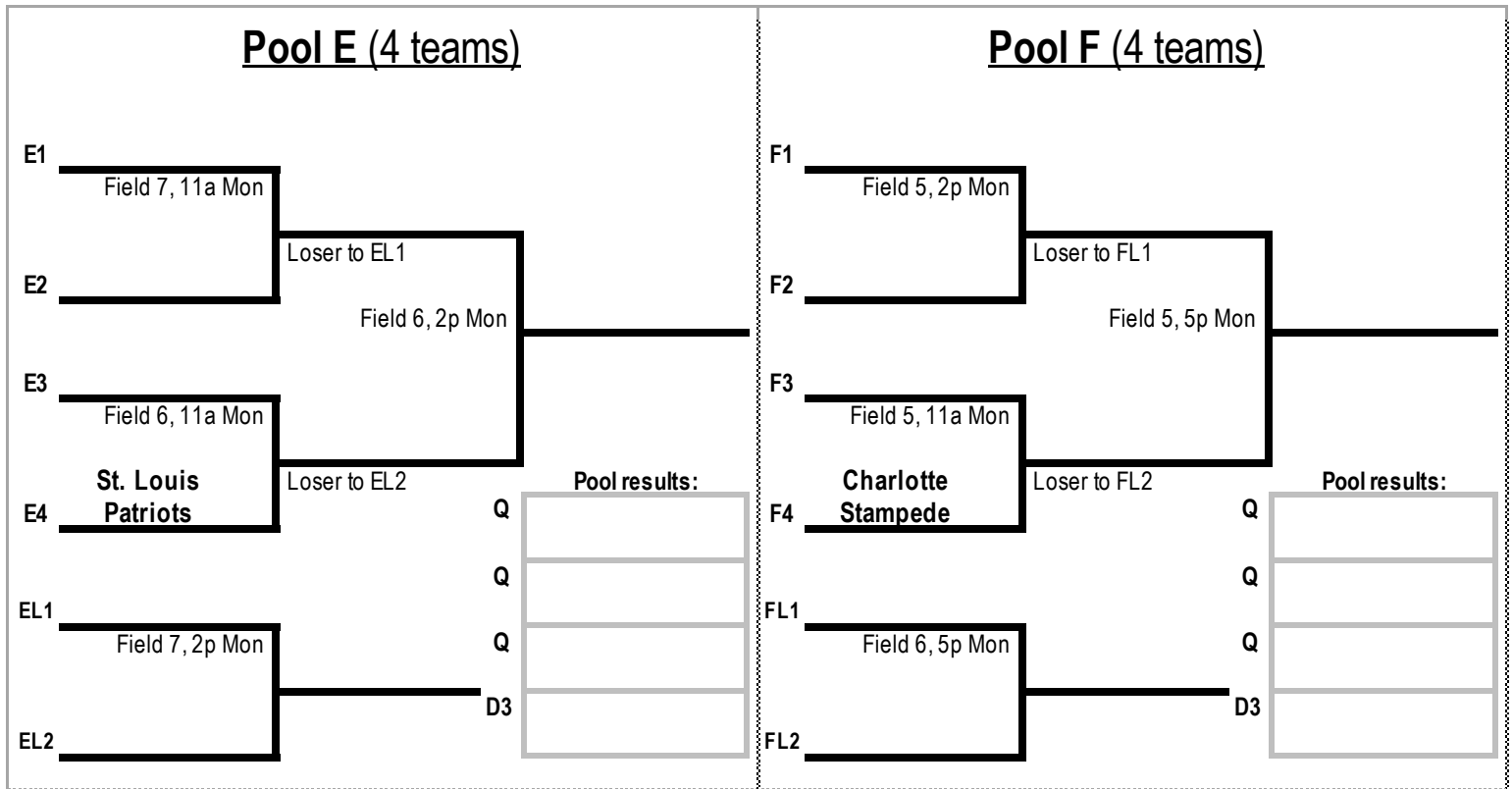

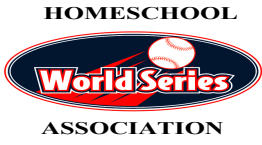
After pool games, we first fill out Div. III, which starts play on Tue. The bottom team from most* pools (sometimes decided via tie-break game) goes to D3, with the other teams advancing to the Q Round.

* This year, there is one more pool (6) than D3 slots (5). Because of this, one "bottom team" will get a berth in the Q round, chosen by applying these seeding criteria to the bottom teams across all pools:

Seeding criteria for selecting the additional Q-round team among bottom teams from each pool:

1. team record
2. run differential (capped at +/- 10 runs per game)
3. runs allowed per defensive inning
4. runs scored per offensive inning
5. coin flip

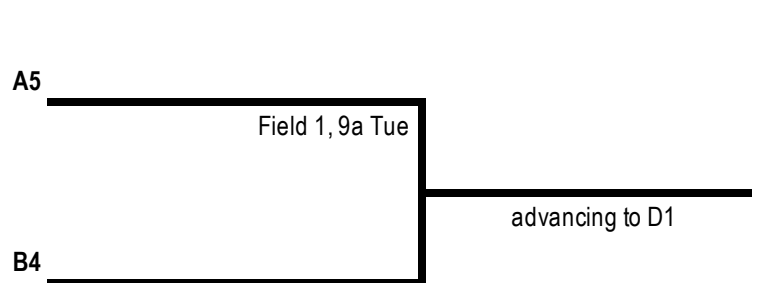
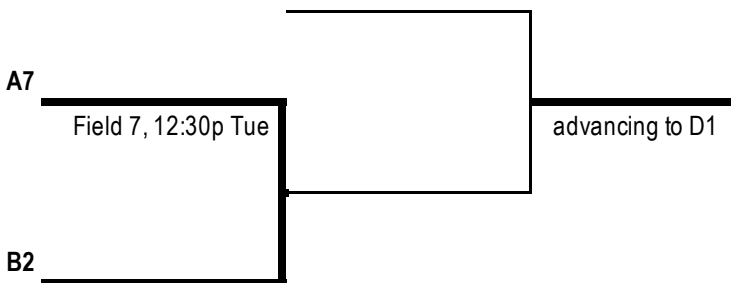
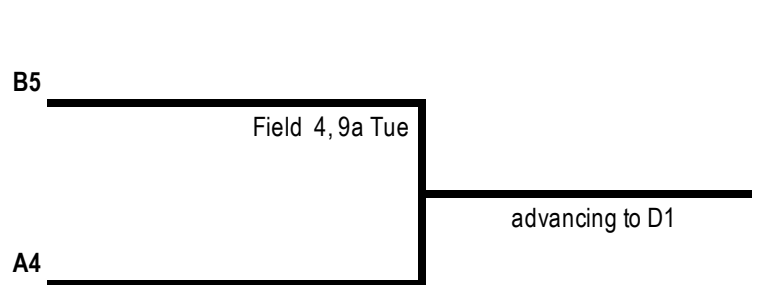
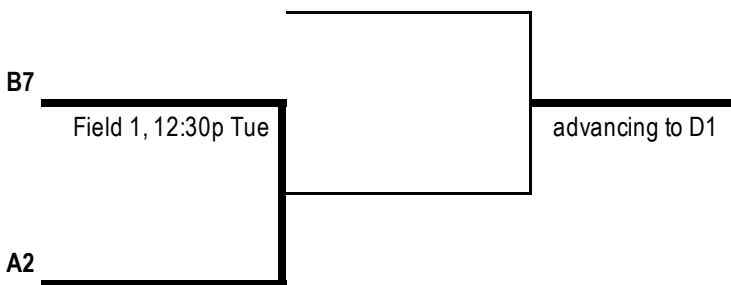
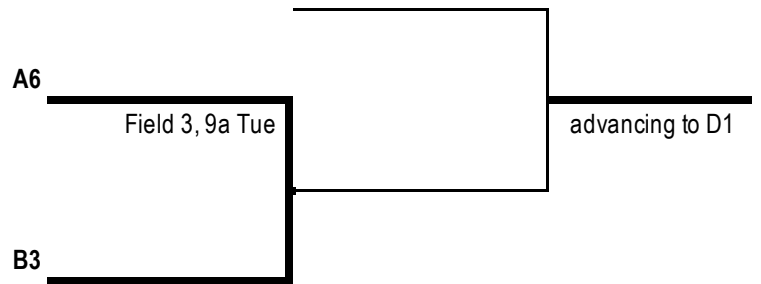
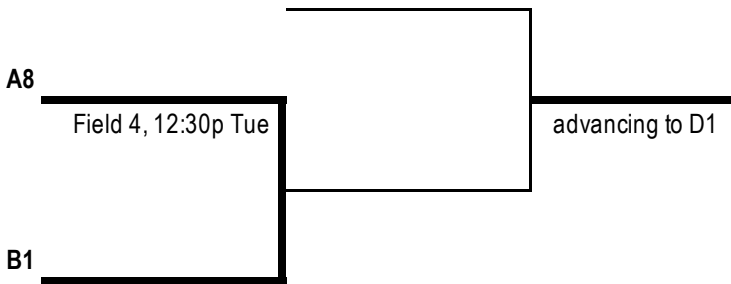
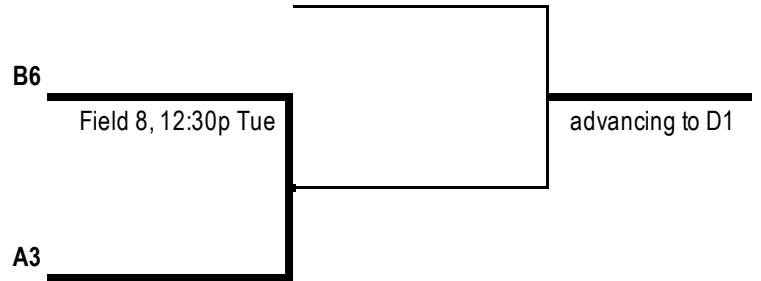
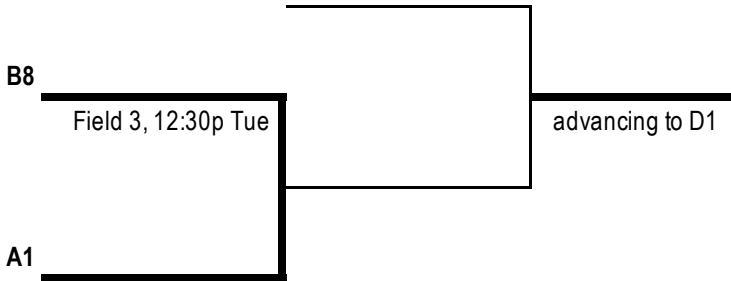
(note: for the same reason, and because team record is the first criterion, if only one 3-team pool ends tied, all of its teams advance to the Q round and there is no tie-breaker needed.)

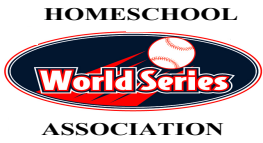


Qualifying Round - Tuesday

Qualifying teams will be divided into 2 groups, each of which is ranked for the Q round seeds by record, game-capped run differential, HTH record, least RA/inning, most RS/inning, coin-flip). Home team is the lower# seed. Q round winners advance to Division I; losers to Division II. Some seeding may await pool tie-breakers at 9a Tue.

Underdog seeds must defeat 2-0 seeds twice to earn a berth in Division I. Replays may be held Thursday 9a if both teams agree; otherwise these are ~4p Tue. The higher# seed is the Home team for the replay. Check hwsa.net for potential schedule updates.



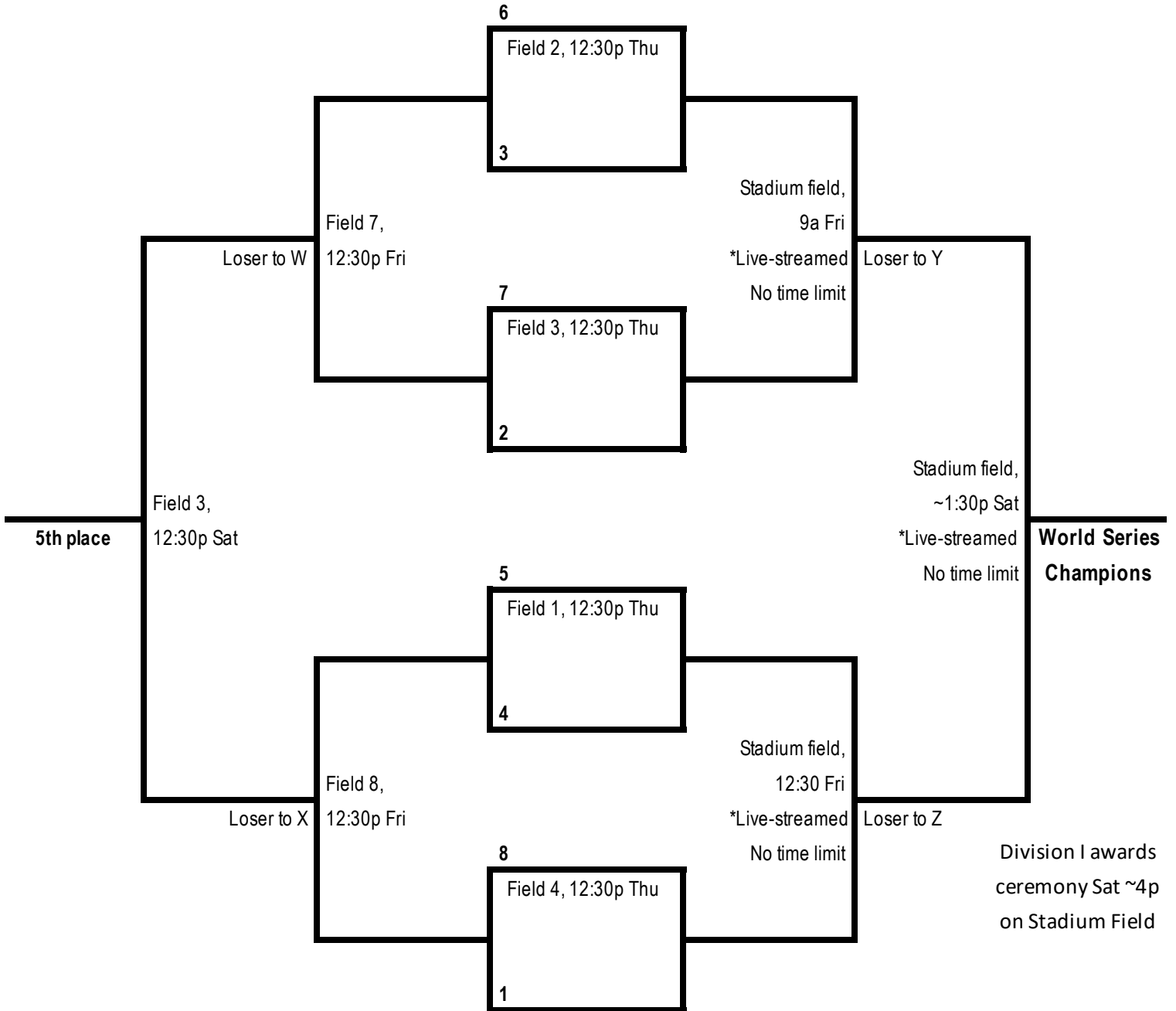

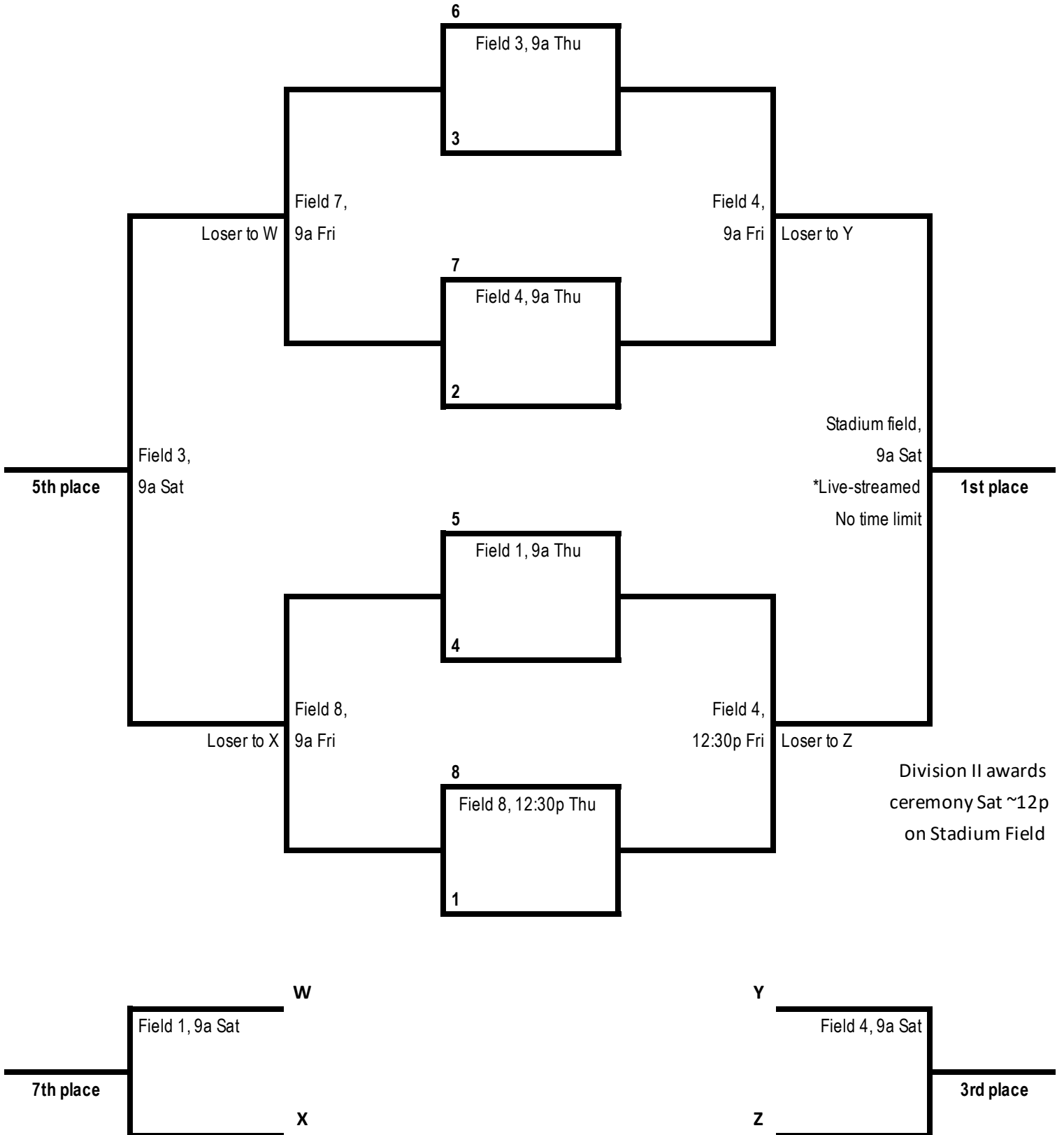


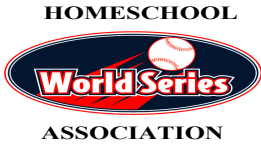
Division II - Thursday through Saturday

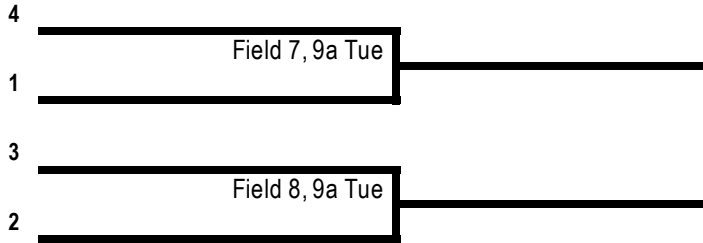




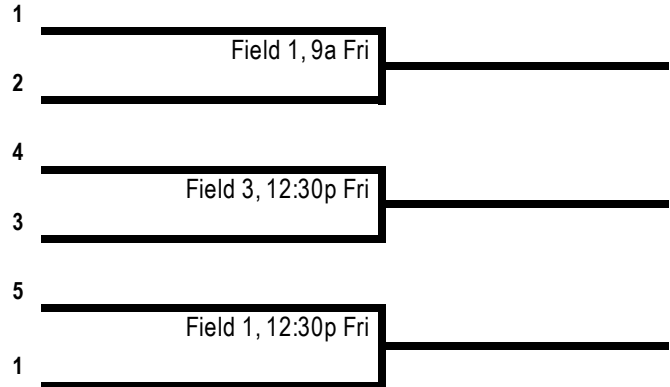
Division III - Tuesday - Friday

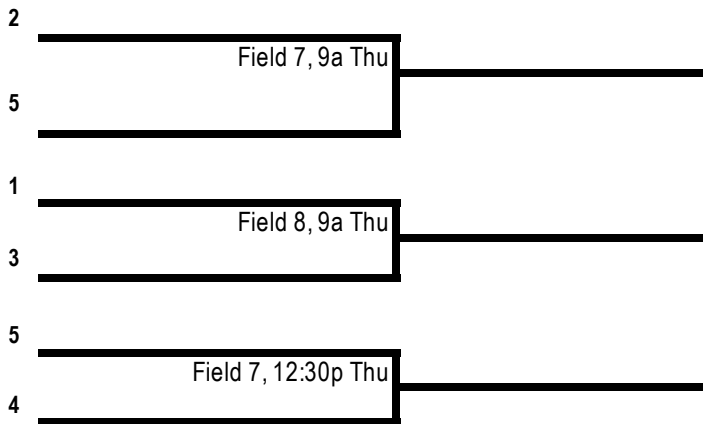
